SHOW AWARDS TO ARTISTS

\$500.00 award for the best work representing the theme, FARMS, FIELDS & FOLIAGE.

\$250.00 award for Judge's Choice for two dimensional art.

\$250.00 award for Judge's Choice for three dimensional art.

\$100.00 People's Choice Award.

Denise Cole, co-owner of the Cole Gallery in Edmonds will judge the 2010 Harvest of Art Show. Denise is a representational painter and well known local gallery owner. Please visit the gallery web site at colegallery.net for additional information.

FEES: \$35.00 for the submission of one original artwork and \$5.00 each for up to TWO additional works. The show jury may select, at their sole discretion, any one or more of the works. Artists may deliver to the show only those works confirmed by the show jury, as accepted into the show. The images submitted to the jury must accurately represent the artists work as delivered to the show. A commission of 15% on all sales will be retained by CAA for show expenses.

Entries will be Judged for awards on Friday, September 24th, 2010. The awards will be presented to the artists during the evening artist's reception held at the Floyd in Stanwood between 7:00 and 9:00 pm., Friday, September 24th.

SALES: All artwork must be for sale and priced by the artists. CAA will retain a commission of 15 % of the sale price. Artists retain the responsibility to pay the sales tax, which will be collected and included in the payment to the Artist.

INSURANCE: The artists are responsible for the insurance of their work. All reasonable care will be taken with the artwork, however damage or loss is possible and participating Artist's understand that no insurance is provided by CAA and show sponsors.

2-D & 3-D Original Art SHOW SET UP

All Art must be delivered in person to the Floyd on Friday, September 24th, between 10 am & 2 pm.

Size: Hanging work size no greater than 34" framed width. Free standing art and sculpture must be stable and no greater than 6' in height and 3' in diameter. Sculpture artists are responsible to set up their artwork in a stable and appropriate manner.

NOTE: Participants in the Juried and Judged Art Show consent to the use of the image they provided in the advertising and promotion for the Harvest Jubilee Art Show. The Image will not be sold or transferred to a third party.
